A representative from MMSTC (Macomb Math and Science Technology Center) will be here on November 20, 2019 to talk with a select group of students, concerning an opportunity for 8th graders. MMSTC is an elite program offered to Macomb county students with exceptional skills in the areas of Math, Science, and Technology. This program is a daily, half day placement during a student's high school career, and takes place at Butcher, which is located near 11 mile Rd. and Ryan. Half of the student's day would be at Butcher and the other half would be at their home school, Lake Shore.

MMSTC has a complete application, testing and recommendation process in place to ensure the best students are chosen. In fact, only 84 freshmen students in the entire county will be chosen from the approximate 400 that will apply and take the 2 tests for placement. **This program is not for everyone.** For this reason, math teachers will be inviting the students who they believe have the best chance for acceptance to listen to the information presented on November 20.
